

US Manipur Baseball Project will realise dreams of players in Manipur

IMPHAL, Nov 4: Finally the small community of baseball players and their well-wishers in the state have a reason to rejoice after a spell of more than two decades of struggle to promote the game despite setbacks due to lack of equipments and formal coaching guidance.

It would be a dream come true for baseball players that the Major League Baseball International, MLB and the US Manipur Baseball Project (First Pitch) will be supporting Manipur's 20 and odd baseball clubs and 700 or so baseball players, as a model for the rest of India by hosting a month-long series of baseball sessions and free camps throughout India.
